# PAKISTAN TRIP TESTIMONY

Mission work has been my calling for long and the last I answered to the call was 15 years ago when I went to Sri Lanka. Commitments after marriage and kids long kept me away from Mission work.

There came a word from God in March when Pastor Yoon was preaching one Sunday and he said it would be good to have an Indian brother joining them for the Pakistan Mission trip. I could not dismiss God's voice this time as it was loud and clear that it was time for me to give my time to God. Moreover, God gave me a new life after my heart attack in December. It was indeed the right time to pay back.

There were many hurdles even right up to the day before the trip. It was not easy getting my leave approved especially since it was the Hari Raya period and my visa was not approved immediately unlike the rest in the trip. The flights were cancelled twice and we had to buy the tickets at almost double the price we had bought the original ticket and at the Dubai airport where we transited and Pakistan airport the medical supplies we had brought along with us were almost confiscated. All the issues were just like passing dark clouds as God's hands were upon all matters so that his will may be done.

It was a 5 days of mission work. We saw how the Pakistanis were hungry for GOD's love. There were thousands of underprivileged who were either disabled or in poverty and were just looking for God's touch and love. I almost teared when I saw the people in suffering.



*When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. Matthew 9:36*

During the 5 days period, we had medical clinic, children's ministry and feast of Pentecost. We worshipped the Lord, shared the gospel and prayed for thousands of people. It was a totally different experience praying for others.

On the first day, I had to use an interpreter to understand the people's request for prayers as I could not speak Urdu. On the second and subsequent days, I did not need an interpreter as the Holy spirit spoke to me on what to pray for each and every one whom I prayed for. I could also feel the anointing flowing from me to the person I prayed for.

*As for you, the Anointing you received from HIM remains in you, and you do not need anyone to teach you. But as HIS Anointing teaches you about all things and as that Anointing is real, not counterfeit—just as it has taught you, remain in HIM. 1 John 2:27*

There was a man I prayed for whom the Holy Spirit told me was yearning for father's love. After I prayed for him, I gave him a hug. The next moment, he was a totally changed person feeling so relieved and exhilarated as if he found the father's love he was looking for. There were many such experiences. We could see the people break free from bondages, generation curses and infirmities as we prayed. Miracles took place during the 5 days period. The blind could see and the lame walked.

It was a fulfilling and enriching experience going to a third world country to do God's work. This is just the beginning of my path to fulfil his purpose on earth.
