The elder prayed generally for me and specifically for my son, asking for him to come to Singapore for Christmas—a desire I had been holding onto as I hadn't seen him in a long time. By God's grace, not only was my prayer answered, but my son came to see me even earlier than expected, arriving within a week. I was overwhelmed with joy and gratitude."
